- Avoid traveling through infestations
- Before leaving an infested area, clean plants and seeds from vehicles, clothing and pets
- Use Weed-Free feed for horses 2-3 days prior to hitting the trail, and during your trip
- Avoid disturbing ground cover
- IF YOU SEE AN INFESTATION, REPORT IT –CALL 310-000 and ask for your nearest Alberta Sustainable Resource Development office.
