



Weed Wise Alberta Invasive Plant Workshop

HOW TO ASSEMBLE AND USE A TRAINING KIT

These are the steps to assemble a training kit:

1. Download the forms and instructions files for advertising and running a workshop.
2. Download the Introductory Core Module, the Special Interest Module of choice, and the weeds from Weed ID Module 1 and Module 2, or from the Invasive Ornamental ID Module that are relevant to the region.
3. Assemble the PowerPoint presentation in the following order:
 1. The Threat of Invasive Plants
 2. Impacts of Invasive Plants
 3. Invasive Plant Control
 4. Choose the Special Interest Module of choice.
 5. Choose the Weed Control Introduction Module.
 6. Choose the weeds from Weed ID Module 1 and Module 2, or from the Invasive Ornamental ID Module that are relevant to the region.
 7. Weed Prevention Strategies

Note: The Weed Control Introduction and Weed ID sections may be done separately.

4. Script: Print one hard copy of all of the slides with the note sections for the presenter to use as a script.
5. Rehearse the presentation to familiarize the presenter with using the script and advancing the presentation where prompted with **CLICK**.
6. Download Invasive plants Fact Sheets and Action Against Weeds sheets as needed.
